### GUIDELINES FOR LEAGUE UMPIRING REPRESENTATIVES TO THE HERTS OTG

1. Attend all O.T.G meetings to represent your league. If you cannot attend the meeting, try and arrange a committee member from your league to attend in your place.
2. Report back to your league any recommendations or guidelines that come from the O.T.G meetings. **Please note certain subjects may come up during the meeting, where the Chairman will ask you not to speak about it outside of the meeting. These subjects should be treated in strict confidence**
3. Circulate to all your league umpires details of the courses planned (see Herts Netball web site <http://www.hertsnetball.co.uk/courses/officiating-courses.html> )
4. Report back to Brian Worrell ([brian.worrell@ridgelea.freeserve.co.uk](mailto:brian.worrell@ridgelea.freeserve.co.uk)) any changes and amendments on active umpire details held on your copy of the Herts Umpires and Officials database. **This database must not be passed onto any person or party without the written permission of the OTG.**
5. Visit the Officials section of the Herts Netball website and become familiar with the wide range of guidelines and information on umpiring subjects to assist in your role. See <http://www.hertsnetball.co.uk/get-involved/officiating.html>
6. When standing down as league representative, you should pass on all paperwork to your successor.
